Location: Event headquarters at St. Margaret's Catholic Church at 13790 South Wintzell Avenue, Bayou La Batre, AL 36509

Distance: Certified 4 Mile and 2 Mile courses that showcase the industries and communities of Bayou La Batre. Courses are flat. Four miler has two turns; 2-Miler is an out and back course. This is the only 4 Mile course in Alabama south of Huntsville. **Run for a record or run for fun – just run.**

Registration: Register by mail (entries should be postmarked by December 15), in person at McCoy Outdoor or Run-N-Tri in Mobile or Running Wild in Fairhope until noon on December 19, or online at Eventbrite.com (<http://bellsinthebayou2013.eventbrite.com>) until midnight December 19. Race day registration at St. Margaret's Church from 6:45 AM – 8:15 AM.
