Registration: Register by mail (entries should be postmarked by September 20 or online Active.com until 4 AM September 26. Packet pick-up and late registration will be available at Happy Harbor on the Line on Friday, September 26 from 5 PM – 8 PM and Saturday, September 27 from 6:30 AM – 7:15 AM

Entry fees: Pre-registered - \$25 Day of Race - \$30
Entry fees include a race shirt and entry to the post-race party at Happy Harbor on the Line. 100% of the event proceeds will be donated to the Prostate Cancer Foundation. If you would like to make an addition donation to the Prostate Cancer Foundation, please add to entry fee. All additional donations will be donated to the PCF.
